



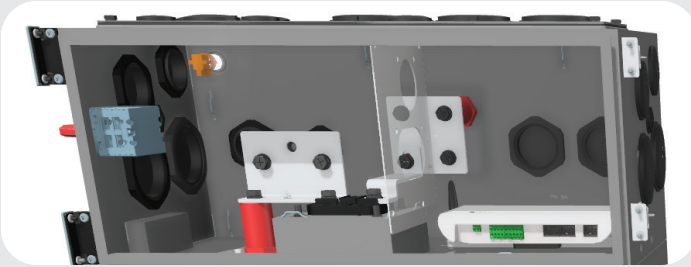

FRONT

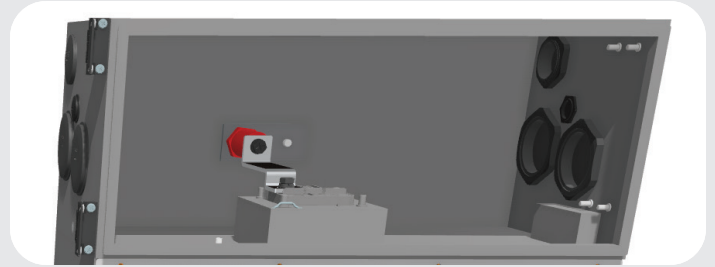
eWay

Three terminal 750A busbar. Used for paralleling multiple batteries. Includes Din rail bracket to mount the Guardian* (optional).



eWay Lite

One 250A Battery Terminal. Does not include din rail bracket to mount the Guardian*.



BACK

Back Knockouts holes | Status indicator | Guardian Wifi Antenna Port

TOP

Removable Top Cover to stack the Envoy Duo 21/12kW/10kW/8kW inverter on the top.



No removable cover. Perfect application when mounting only one Envoy Duo 21/12kW/10kW/8kW inverter to the side of the battery.

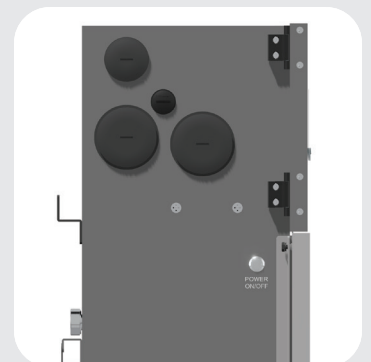


SIDE

Power Switch included. Includes Rapid Shutdown Switch on the eWay for battery, PV and AC Output.



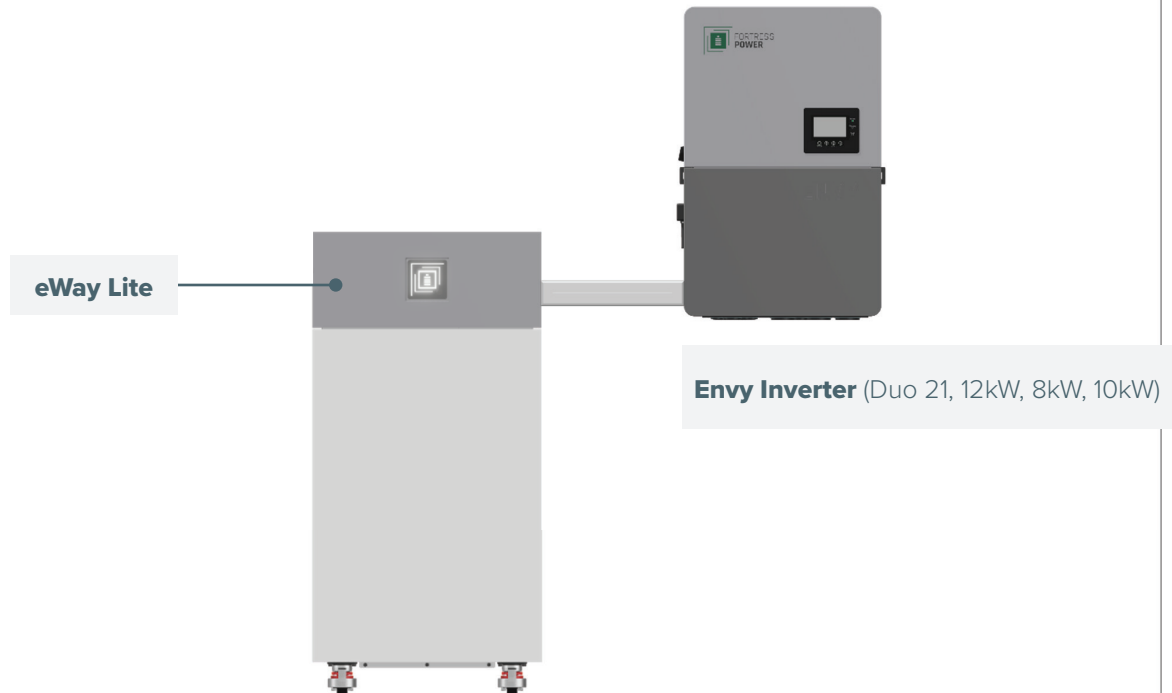
Power Switch included. Does not include Rapid Shutdown to turn off battery when RSD is enabled.



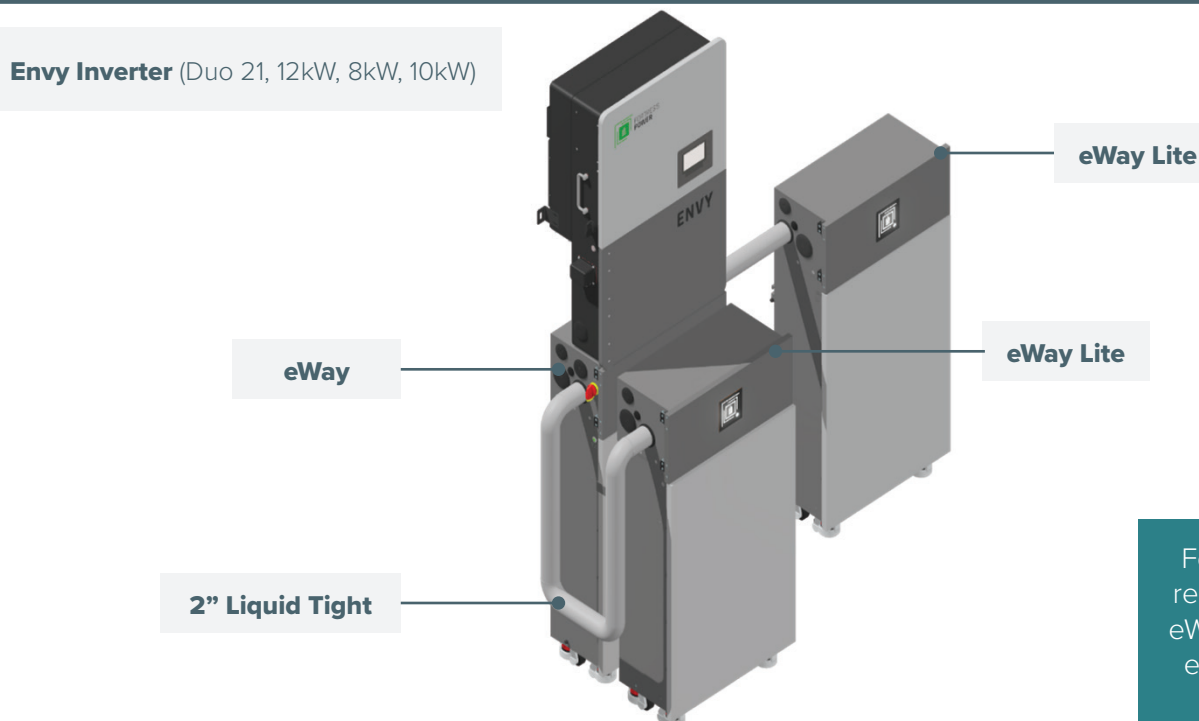
